On September 17, 2004, NASD filed SR-NASD-2004-141 to amend Rule 2711 to prohibit (1) a research analyst from participating in a road show related to an investment banking services transaction and from engaging in any communication with a current or prospective customer in the presence of investment banking department personnel or company management about an investment banking services transaction and (2) investment banking department personnel from directing a research analyst to engage in sales and marketing efforts and other communications with a customer about an investment banking services transaction.

On February 4, 2005, NASD filed Amendment No. 1 to the proposed rule change, which added a provision that any permissible written or oral communication by a research analyst with a current or prospective customer or internal personnel related to an investment banking services transaction must be fair, balanced and not misleading, taking into consideration the overall context in which the communication is made.

NASD is filing this partial amendment to clarify that Amendment No. 1 is intended to replace in its entirety the original proposed rule change submitted on September 17, 2004. Accordingly, please insert the following sentence at the beginning of the "Purpose" section on page 5 of the Form 19b-4 filing and page 12 of Exhibit 1 to that filing:

Amendment No. 1 to the proposed rule change replaces the text of the original rule filing in its entirety.
