Notice has been received that the above company's First Modified Plan of Reorganization (Plan) filed under Chapter XI of the Federal Bankruptcy Code, became effective on May 18, 1999.

Under the Plan, holders of record May 18, 1999 received in January, 2000 1 share of MORO Corporation (MRCR) for every 28.05 shares of old common stock held.

Since surrender of the OLD certificates was not required and are deemed worthless as of the effective date, deliveries after May 18, 1999 in settlement of contracts in OLD common stock should be evidenced by the equivalent in New common stock.

Notice has been received that the above company's Plan of Reorganization (Plan) filed under Chapter XI of the Federal Bankruptcy Code, became effective on September 14, 2000. Pursuant to the Plan, holders of the above referenced securities **will not** receive any distributions of property on account of their interests.

Members are reminded of their obligations under NASD Conduct Rule 2310 if they continue to engage in transactions in the above security after the effective date.

Members are further advised that deliveries in settlement of contracts in the **OLD** securities, which were executed prior to the announcement that the securities had been deemed worthless, shall be evidenced by either a) the **OLD** security; or b) a *Letter of Indemnity* which shall grant the purchaser any rights and privileges which might accrue to the holders of the physical securities. Such deliveries shall operate to close-out the contract and shall be settled at the existing contract price pursuant to Rule 11530 (formerly Uniform Practice Code Section 27) subsection (b) (1) and (b) (2) adopted November 1, 1991.
