CASE SUMMARY

Claimant asserted the following causes of action: violation of industry rules; failure to register in Florida; violation of Section 517.301 of the Florida Statutes; breach of contract; breach of fiduciary duty; failure to properly diversify Claimant's portfolio; failure to follow instructions; common law fraud; negligence; and, failure to adequately supervise. The causes of action relate to the purchase and sale of shares of numerous stocks in Claimant's account including, but not limited to: Sycamore Networks; Priceline.Com; Ebay; Infospace, Inc.; JDS Uniphase Corp.; and, Verisign, Inc.

Unless specifically admitted in their Answer, Respondents denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimant requested compensatory damages in the amount of \$3,300,000.00, plus interest at the legal rate from the date of purchase, or reasonable market return, rescission, attorney's fees to be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction, punitive damages, costs and any other relief deemed just and proper.

Respondents requested judgment dismissing Claimant's claims, expungement of all references to this matter from Respondent Kronitz's registration records maintained by the NASD Central Registration Depository ("CRD"), assessment of all costs and expenses of this proceeding against Claimant and any other relief deemed just and proper.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

During a pre-hearing conference with the Panel on February 21, 2003, Respondents verbally objected to Claimant's Emergency Motion to Amend the Statement of Claim. Thereafter, on or about February 21, 2003, the Panel issued an order which denied Claimant's Emergency Motion to Amend the Statement of Claim.

On or about July 28, 2003, the Panel conducted a telephonic, post-hearing conference to select the date to conduct an in-person, post-hearing conference to address Respondent MSDW's Motion to Modify Award. On or about July 28, 2003, the Panel issued an order which set the in-person, post-hearing conference for August 15, 2003.

On or about July 31, 2003, the Panel issued an order which denied Claimant's Motion to Reschedule the In-Person, Post-Hearing Conference.

On or about August 6, 2003, the Panel issued an order which denied Claimant's application for reconsideration of the request to reschedule the August 15, 2003 in-person, post-hearing conference.

On or about August 15, 2003, the Panel issued an order which stated that the Panel lacked jurisdiction to rule on Respondent MSDW's Motion to Modify Award. In addition, the Panel denied Claimant's Motion for Sanctions.

The parties have agreed that the Amended Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

Respondent MSDW is found liable to Claimant on the claim of failure to adequately supervise. As such, Respondent MSDW shall pay to Claimant compensatory damages in the amount of \$100,000.00, pre- and post-judgment interest specifically excluded.

The Panel finds no violations of law under Section 517.301 of the Florida Statutes.

Claimant's claims against Respondent Kronitz are denied in their entirety.

Any and all claims for relief not specifically addressed herein, including Claimant's request for punitive damages and Respondent Kronitz's request for expungement, are denied.

FEES

Pursuant to the NASD Code of Arbitration Procedure (the "Code"), the following fees are assessed:

Filing Fees

NASD Dispute Resolution will retain or collect the non-refundable filing fees for each claim:

Initial claim filing fee	=	\$600.00
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Member Fees

Member fees are assessed to each member firm that is a party in these proceedings or to the member firm that employed the associated person at the time of the events giving rise to the dispute. In this matter, the member firm is a party.

Member surcharge	=	\$2,500.00
Pre-hearing process fee	=	\$ 600.00
Hearing process fee	=	\$4,500.00

Adjournment Fees

No requests for adjournment were filed in this matter.

Injunctive Relief Fees

No injunctive relief fees were incurred in this matter.

Forum Fees and Assessments

The Panel has assessed forum fees for each session conducted. A session is any meeting between the parties and the arbitrators, including a pre-hearing conference with the arbitrators, that lasts four (4) hours or less. Fees associated with these proceedings are:

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
