Respondent signed the Uniform Submission Agreement: October 12, 2002.

CASE SUMMARY

Claimants asserted the following causes of action: failure to supervise; misrepresentation; suitability; negligence; violation of Section 517.301 of the Florida Statutes; breach of contract; breach of fiduciary duty; and common law fraud. The causes of action relate to the purchase and sale of unspecified stocks in Claimants' accounts.

Unless specifically admitted in its Answer and Amended Answer, Respondent denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted various affirmative defenses.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimants requested compensatory damages of \$500,000.00; interest at the legal rate from the date of purchase or reasonable market return; rescission; reasonable attorneys' fees to be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction; punitive damages; costs; and for such other relief as is just and proper.

Respondent requested dismissal of the Statement of Claim in its entirety; costs; expenses; and attorneys' fees.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

After the Claimants rested, Respondent made an ore tenus Motion to Dismiss the Statement of Claim. The Panel denied said motion.

The parties agreed that the Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies or that a handwritten, signed Award may be entered.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

Respondent is liable on the claims of suitability and negligence and shall pay to Claimants the following: to Claimant Shep Alster compensatory damages of \$250,000.00 plus post award interest which begins to accrue 30 days from the date of the Award until the date of payment of the Award at the Florida legal rate of 6% per annum; to Claimant Shep Alster as Custodian for Jennifer Alster compensatory damages of \$18,549.00 plus post award interest which begins to accrue 30 days from the date of the Award until the date of payment of the Award at the Florida legal rate of 6% per annum; and, to Claimant Shep Alster as custodian for Jessica Alster compensatory damages of \$13,439.00 plus post award interest which begins to accrue 30 days from the date of the Award until the date of payment of the Award at the Florida legal rate of 6% per annum.

Claimants Shep Alster PAS, Shep Alster PAS/Harris Bretall, Shep Alster as Custodian for Ryan Alster and Shep Alster IRA's claims for relief are denied in their entirety.

Any and all requests relief not specifically addressed herein, including Claimants' claims for relief pursuant to Section 517.301 of the Florida Statutes, the parties' requests for attorneys' fees, and the Claimants' requests for punitive damages, are denied.

FEES

Injunctive Relief Fees

Injunctive relief fees are assessed to each member or associated person who files for a temporary injunction in court. Parties in these cases are also assessed arbitrator travel expenses and costs when an arbitrator is required to travel outside his or her hearing location and additional arbitrator honoraria for the hearing for permanent injunction. These fees, except the injunctive relief surcharge, are assessed equally against each party unless otherwise directed by the panel.


