Claimants, Robert R. Hoffman, Jr. and Kathleen A. Hoffman, hereinafter collectively referred to as "Claimants", were represented by Peter B. Skeel, Esq., Summers, McDonnell, Walsh & Skeel, L.L.P., Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Respondent, Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. ("Merrill Lynch"), was represented by Stuart T. Rebish, Esq., Office of General Counsel, Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc., New York, New York.

Respondent, Larry Goehring ("Goehring"), was represented by Gerry J. Kowalski, Esq., Marshall, Dennehey, Warner, Coleman & Goggin, P.C., Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

CASE INFORMATION

Statement of Claim filed on April 8, 2004.

Claimants signed the Uniform Submission Agreement on March 20, 2004.

Statement of Answer filed by Respondents Merrill Lynch and Goehring on July 30, 2004.

Robert E. Goldberg, Director and Senior Counsel, executed Respondent Merrill Lynch's Uniform Submission Agreement on July 30, 2004.

Respondent Goehring signed the Uniform Submission Agreement on June 1, 2004.

CASE SUMMARY

Claimants asserted the following causes of action, among others: breach of contract, negligence, breach of fiduciary duty and failure to supervise. The causes of action relate to the purchase and sale of mutual funds including Merrill Lynch Global Tech Fund Class D, Internet Port 2000 Series, Blackrock Small Cap Growth Equity Portfolio Class C, and Aim Value Fund Class A.

Unless specifically admitted in their Answer, Respondents Merrill Lynch and Goehring denied the allegations made in the Statement of Claim and asserted the following defenses, among

others: failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted, claims are barred by the applicable statutes of limitations, estoppel, waiver, ratification, laches, proximate cause, and failure to mitigate damages.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimants in their Statement of Claim requested:

Compensatory Damages	\$ 68,403.00

Respondents Merrill Lynch and Goehring in their Statement of Answer requested that the Statement of Claim be dismissed in its entirety, expungement of all references to the Statement of Claim and the allegations therein from Respondent Goehring's Central Registration Depository ("CRD") record, that they be awarded costs, and that reasonable attorney's fees be assessed against the Claimant.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The parties have agreed that the Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Panel has decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

1. Claimants' claims are dismissed with prejudice;
2. Respondents Merrill Lynch and Goehring's request for expungement of Respondent Goehring's CRD record is denied with prejudice;
3. The parties shall bear their respective costs, except as Fees are specifically addressed below; and
4. Any and all relief not specifically addressed herein is denied in its entirety.




