

On April 26, 1989, the undersigned arbitrators heard the controversy between the parties as set forth in submissions to arbitration signed by Claimant Annette Ford, and by Respondents WZW Financial Services, Inc., Swinton B. Burkhalter and Landsing Capital Corporation. The arbitration panel, having considered the pleadings, the testimony, and the evidence presented at the hearing, has determined in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

1. The Claim of Respondent Swinton B. Burkhalter against Landsing Capital Corporation is dismissed;
2. The Respondents WZW Financial Services, Inc. and Swinton B. Burkhalter shall be liable and pay to Claimant Annette Ford the sum of Twelve Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$12,800.00), such amount representing the Claimant's actual damages including interest per annum at seven percent (7%) for four years;
3. The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorneys' fees;
5. Pursuant to Section 43 of the Code of Arbitration Procedure, the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. shall retain the Seven Hundred Dollar and No Cent (\$750.00) filing fee previously deposited by the Claimant.
