

On May 9, 1989, the undersigned arbitrators heard the controversy between the parties as set forth in submissions to arbitration signed by Claimant Raymond J. Jenkins on May 31, 1988, and by Respondent The Stuart-James Company, Inc. on July 21, 1988. The arbitration panel, having considered the pleadings, the testimony, and the evidence presented at the hearing, has determined in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

1. The claim of the Claimant Raymond J. Jenkins against the Respondent The Stuart-James Company, Inc. shall be denied.
2. The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorneys' fees.
5. Pursuant to Section 43 of the Code of Arbitration Procedure, the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. shall refund the Four Hundred Dollar and No Cents (\$400.00) filing fee previously deposited by the Claimant.

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
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
