CASE SUMMARY

Claimant(s) Hancock Techtronics, Inc. alleged that Respondent(s) Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc. negligently mishandled Claimant's account held with Respondent. Respondent(s) denies Claimant's allegations.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimant(s) Hancock Techtronics, Inc. requested damages of Seven Thousand Three Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$7,300.00). Respondent(s) requested dismissal of claim and costs.

AWARD

Pursuant to Section 13 of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Simplified Arbitration") a single arbitrator, Alison C. Schuler, Esq., was selected to review and determine the matter in controversy between the parties set forth in submissions to Arbitration signed by the Claimant(s) on December 5, 1988 and by Respondent(s) on April 7, 1989, respectively;

And, that the Arbitrator, having considered the proofs of the Parties, including any additional documentary submissions of the Claimant(s) and the Respondents(s) has decided and determined in full and final resolution of the issue submitted for determination as follows:

The claim against the Respondent shall be dismissed in its entirety.

The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorney's fees.

The \$200.00 filing fee previously deposited with the NASD, Inc. by the Claimant(s) shall be retained by the NASD as costs of this proceeding.
