CASE SUMMARY

Claimant(s) Manocher Rastgou alleged that Respondent(s) Greystone Nash, Inc. and Christian A. Ribeiraud fraudulently misrepresented to Claimant material facts concerning Claimant's investment with Respondent. Respondent(s) deny all allegations.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimant(s) Manocher Rastgou requested damages of One Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000.00). Respondent(s) requested dismissal of claim and costs.

AWARD

Pursuant to Section 13 of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Simplified Arbitration") a single arbitrator, Perry E. Wallace, Esq., was selected to review and determine the matter in controversy between the parties set forth in submissions to Arbitration signed by the Claimant(s) on January 30, 1989 and by Respondent(s) on May 1, 1989. The Arbitrator, having considered the proofs of the parties, has determined in full and final resolution of the issue submitted for determination as follows:

The claim against Respondent shall be dismissed in its entirety.

The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorney's fees.

The \$15.00 filing fee previously deposited with the NASD, Inc. by the Claimant(s) shall be retained by the NASD as costs of this proceeding.
