**CASE SUMMARY**

Claimant(s) Donald F. Gamer and Terry A. Gamer alleged that Respondent(s) Jane Nize made misrepresentations. Respondent(s) did not respond.

**RELIEF REQUESTED**

Claimant(s) Donald F. Gamer and Terry A. Gamer requested damages of Three Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Forty Cents (\$3,633.40).

**AWARD**

Pursuant to Section 13 of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Simplified Arbitration") a single arbitrator, David I. Bursten, Esq., was selected to review and determine the matter in controversy between the parties set forth in submissions to Arbitration signed by the Claimant(s) on April 25, 1989 and not by the Respondent as required by Section 12(a) of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure;

And, that the Arbitrator, having considered the proofs of the Parties, including any additional documentary submissions of the Claimant(s) and the Respondents(s) has decided and determined in full and final resolution of the issue submitted for determination as follows:

The Respondent is liable and shall pay the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and Forty Cents (\$3,633.40) to the Claimant.

The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorney's fees.

The \$100.00 filing fee previously deposited with the NASD, Inc. by the Claimant(s) shall be retained by the NASD as costs of this proceeding.
