CASE SUMMARY

Claimant(s) David C. Bojanic alleged that Respondent(s) Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc. and Kevin Marcum made numerous misrepresentations, recommended unsuitable investments and mismanaged Claimant's account. Respondent(s) denied all allegations.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimant(s) David C. Bojanic requested damages of One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$1,700.00). Respondent(s) requested dismissal of claim and costs.

AWARD

Pursuant to Section 13 of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Simplified Arbitration") a single arbitrator, Thomas B. Corey, Esq., was selected to review and determine the matter in controversy between the parties set forth in submissions to Arbitration signed by the Claimant(s) on June 30, 1989 and by Respondent(s) on September 15, 1989 and October 10, 1989, respectively;

And, that the Arbitrator, having considered the proofs of the Parties, including any additional documentary submissions of the Claimant(s) and the Respondents(s) has decided and determined in full and final resolution of the issue submitted for determination as follows:

The Respondent Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc. is separately liable and shall pay to Claimant the sum of Eight Hundred Eighty Dollars and No Cents (\$880.00).

The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorney's fees.

The \$25.00 filing fee previously deposited with the NASD, Inc. by the Claimant(s) shall be refunded to the Claimant by the Respondent Blinder, Robinson & Co., Inc..
