CASE SUMMARY

Claimant(s) Evelyn Myrl & Gerald Jay Blount alleged that Respondent(s) Century Financial Securities, Inc. and Scott Sengleman accepted Claimants' funds by check, failed to invest such funds as requested by Claimants, and subsequently denied receiving said funds. Respondent(s) failed to defend.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimant(s) Evelyn Myrl & Gerald Jay Blount requested damages of One Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$1,000.00).

AWARD

Pursuant to Section 13 of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure ("Simplified Arbitration") a single arbitrator, Langdon T. Owen, Jr., Esq., was selected to review and determine the matter in controversy between the parties set forth in submissions to Arbitration signed by the Claimant(s) on May 14, 1990 and not by the Respondents as required by Section 12(a) of the NASD, Inc. Code of Arbitration Procedure;

And, that the Arbitrator, having considered the proofs of the Parties, including any additional documentary submissions of the Claimant(s) and the Respondent(s) has decided and determined in full and final resolution of the issue submitted for determination as follows:

That the Respondents are jointly and severally liable and shall pay to the Claimant the sum of One Thousand Ninety Two Dollars and No Cents (\$1,092.00), which sum includes interest, and;

That the sum of One Thousand Ninety Two Dollars and No Cents (\$1,092.00) shall bear interest at 10% per annum from October 25, 1990 until paid in full.

The parties shall each bear their respective costs including attorney's fees.

The \$15.00 filing fee previously deposited with the NASD, Inc. by the Claimant(s) shall be jointly and severally refunded to the Claimant by the Respondents.
