
RESTATED AWARD


The captioned matter was submitted on February 8, 1990. The named parties appeared at a hearing on Thursday, May 17, 1990 in Chicago, Illinois, and had full opportunity to present arguments and evidence. The above captioned controversy involved the following issues:

Mr. Anderson alleged that he entered into a transaction in the OEX pit with Mr. Frost. Mr. Frost claimed that the option that he traded with Mr. Anderson was a different strike price than the option that Mr. Anderson actually sold.

The undersigned arbitrators award as follows:

Mr. Frost will pay Mr. Anderson the sum of One Thousand Twenty-Five Dollars (\$1,025). Filing fees on deposit with the Exchange are retained.
