CASE SUMMARY

Claimant alleged misrepresentation and breach of contract in connection with the purchase of municipal bonds and their subsequent calls.

Respondent denied the allegations of wrongdoing set forth in the Claimant's Statement of Claim.

RELIEF REQUESTED

Claimant requested \$30,600.00 in compensatory damages.

Respondent requested dismissal of the Claimant's Statement of Claim in its entirety.

OTHER ISSUES CONSIDERED AND DECIDED

The parties agreed that the Award in this matter may be executed in counterpart copies or that a handwritten, signed Award may be entered.

AWARD

After considering the pleadings, testimony, and evidence presented at the hearing, the Arbitrator decided in full and final resolution of the issues submitted for determination as follows:

Respondent, Wells Fargo Securities, Inc, is liable to and shall pay Claimant \$6,653.00 in damages.

All other relief requested not expressly granted is denied.

FEES

Pursuant to the Code, the following fees are assessed:

Filing Fees

Forum Fees and Assessments

(1) Hearing session @ \$450.00/session	= \$ 450.00
Hearing: December 6, 2000 1 session	
Total Forum Fees	= \$ 900.00
